## GUIDELINES FOR THE 'YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD' OF THE ISSGPU SOCIETY

## **IMPORTANT INSTRACTIONS:**


- 1. The candidate shall be a LIFE MEMBER of the society.
- 2. Should attach the ISSGPU life membership as well as date of Birth Certificate.
- 3. Two hard copies of application form along with up-to-date list of 10 publications along with SCI impact factor/NAAS factor. Both copies must include the front page of the 10 full research publications, other publications, all relevant certificates and documents as per the given format as proof. Applicant has to be submitted the soft copy of the application by e-mail to Secretary, ISSGPU. Research papers on sheep, goat and rabbits will only be considered for the assessment.
- 4. Application not completed in all respects and not accompanied by list of publications (a list of up to 10 most important publications) and other documents will not be considered. One set of reprints/front page of the 10 research articles must be submitted; otherwise application will not be valid for consideration.
- 5. "Application for Young Scientist Award" should be written on the envelope containing the application.
- 6. Application completed in all respects is to be sent by Registered/Speed Post or personally to the Secretary, ISSGPU so as to reached by 30.11.2021.
- 7. Application will be screened by the secretary, ISSGPU. A committee will be constituted by the president ISSGPU and will make a decision of the candidate's scientific attainments and achievement for Young Scientist Award.
- 8. ISSGPU Society has initiated 'Young Scientist Award' in the year 2017. The age of the candidate/applicant should not be more than **35** years as on 30.11.2021 (last day of application submission). Young Scientist Awardee must have **one year of life membership** of ISSGPU society. Award will be given strictly on the basis of contribution of the scientist towards research on small ruminants. The candidate must have at least **10 full research publications** on sheep/goat or rabbit with 5.25 or above NAAS impact factor. For evaluation of the awardee, application proforma (publication, SCI/NAAS impact factor, achievement and patent etc.) will be utilized as a criteria for selection of the awardee. A committee will decide to give the award or may not propose any award, if the suitable application is not received. All application will be submitted to Secretary, ISSGPU. Applications will be screened by Secretary, ISSGPU regarding the eligibility and other terms and conditions (*Enclosed the proof of each items*).
- 9. The minimum cut-off markers will be 60%. If the candidate is not achieved 60% mark then his/her application will be automatically rejected. If single application is received and has score of 60% or more then it will be considered.
- 10. THE AWARDEE WILL BE HONOURED WITH A CERTIFICATE AND A PLAQUE ON THE OCCASION OF THE SEMINAR OF THE YEAR.

Cumulative NAAS Index less than 40 points: 5 marks; from 41 to 50 points: 10 marks; from 51-60 points: 15 marks; from 61 to 70 points: 20 marks, from 71 to more points: 25 marks. (For 2 extra points from the initial value, then one or more marks will be given accordingly). If the candidate has published at least 10 publications in the ISSGPU journal "Indian Journal of Small Ruminant Research" then 10 cumulative points will be given extra, which will be equivalent to 2 marks.
